College Legends

College Legends, formally (Living Treasures) recognise people that have made a significant contribution to the development of the College, from its founding to the current day.

Criteria for appointment:

- 1. For College Board/Advisory Committee/School Advisory Committee contributions, minimum eligibility:
 - Membership for two terms
- 2. For employees:
 - Employment for 10 years
- 3. Qualitative criteria for both categories:
 - Significant contribution of time and skills through College Board/Advisory
 Committee/School Advisory Committee linked to important junctures in College history.
 - Significant contributions above and beyond paid role, e.g., College Production, Catholic Identity Events, camps, concerts, sporting teams, tutoring, student support, marketing etc.
- 4. These would then translate as:
 - A significant contribution to Catholic Identity and culture
 - An outstanding contribution to the development of the facilities
 - The advancement of the standing within the educational and local community
 - An extraordinary contribution to the achievement and learning growth of students
 - An outstanding dedication or significant contribution to the extra-curricular

Note the College Executive may nominate an individual to the School Advisory Committee outside of this criterion who has contributed in a significant way to the growth of the College.

Process for appointment:

- 1. The broad community, staff, students, and families would be invited to nominate each year persons who they felt met these criteria
- 2. The College Executive would shortlist those who met the eligibility criteria and recommend new awardees
- 3. These recipients would then be ratified by the School Advisory Committee
- 4. A commemorative item and a letter of acknowledgment would be presented at Presentation Night
- 5. Names and bios would then be posted on the College website and published in Camino
