# About the course

- The Certificate III in Music (Sound Production) qualification is a two-year course in which students develop the skills required to:
  - Record and mix music at home or in a studio environment, using modern sound production techniques and equipment.
  - Record and mix music in a broadcast environment e.g. podcasts, lectures, radio, film/tv.
  - o Set-up and mix live sound and music e.g. bands, duos, solo performers.
- All VET qualifications are nationally recognised by both employers and industries and further education providers (such as a TAFE or private training organisation).



# Pre-requisites:

Saint Francis Xavier College requires students to have satisfactorily completed two semesters of secondary school music subjects [Music Performance, Cantabile, Extension Academy: Performing Arts]

(exceptions will be made on a case by case basis)




# Course structure

Assessment methods may include Written assessments, work performance and portfolios






### Practical tasks

Students in VET Music will be required to:

- Record and mix instruments and voices to a professional level using state-of-the-art, school-supplied recording equipment and software.
- Visit and utilise an off-campus professional recording studio each year.
- Set up and mix sound for various school music activities, such as Cantabile and live performances in front of a school audience.
