Education Fee Schedule 2025

Annual Tuition Fees 2025

Education Fee \$7,350

The education fee includes:

- Comprehensive Curriculum Program
- Digital Learning Program
- Capital Building Programs
- Incursions / Excursions
- Compulsory Camps
- VET/VCE Vocational Major Programs (if applicable)

The inability to attend class, camps and/or excursions will not result in a refund or credit.

Bus Fee

An annual bus ticket in 2025 will cost \$1,100 (including GST). This includes shuttle only services. This increase reflects additional costs being incurred by our bus company.

Music Tuition Fees

Additional music tuition is an optional program, invoiced at the beginning of each term. Music tuition fees are due and payable upon invoicing and must be finalised in the term they are invoiced. Music Tuition Fees for 2025 remain unchanged:

Group lesson – 30 minutes	\$220 per term
Individual lesson – 30 Minutes	\$330 per term
Individual lesson – 45 minutes	\$495 per term
Individual lesson – 60 minutes	\$660 per term

Discounts

Health Care Card/Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund (CSEF)

Families who hold a valid Health Care Card and who have provided a signed CSEF application form to the College will receive a 70% discount off the 2025 Education Fee. This discount is calculated after any family discounts are applied to the account. For split billing accounts, the discount applies to the Health Care Card holders account only.

Family Discount

Family discounts are provided to families with multiple children attending the College. The discount will be applied pro rata to split billing accounts. Annual discounts as follows:

2 children	\$675
3 children	\$2,700
4 children	\$6,750
5 children	\$13,500

Early Payment Discount

An early payment discount per student applies to 2025 annual accounts paid in full (including any previous fees) by the following dates:

31 January 2025	\$200 discount per student
28 February 2025	\$100 discount per student

This discount will be applied pro rata to split billing accounts. Families receiving CSEF funding are ineligible for the early payment discount. For further information, eligibility and to download a CSEF application form, visit <https://sfx.vic.edu.au/admissions/fees/>

Travel Conveyance Allowance

Students travelling to the College by private bus (St Francis Xavier College Buses), public transport or private car may be eligible for the Travel Conveyance Allowance. Claims considered eligible by the Department of Education will be credited against the education fee account. Students at the Berwick Campus do not qualify for the Travel Conveyance Allowance. Important Dates

Should you prefer to pay by instalments, fees for each term are payable by the end of each term. **All 2025 accounts must be finalised by 31 December 2025.**

6 January 2025	Billing for 2025 fees processed and invoices sent within 7 days
4 April 2025	Term 1 portion of fees due
4 July 2025	Term 2 portion of fees due
19 September 2025	Term 3 portion of fees due
31 December 2025	All 2025 accounts to be finalised

Withdrawal of Students

If a student is withdrawn from the College, a term's notice and signed exit form must be completed by Parents, Guardians or Carers. Failure to do so will incur tuition fees in lieu of notice. Please contact your child's campus reception for further information.

Payment Options

Direct Debit	This is our preferred method. Direct debits can be set up for bank accounts or credit card payments. Direct Debit forms can be returned at any time, and payments can be made prior to billing. Any credit balance on an account will be held and applied to future billing and charges.
